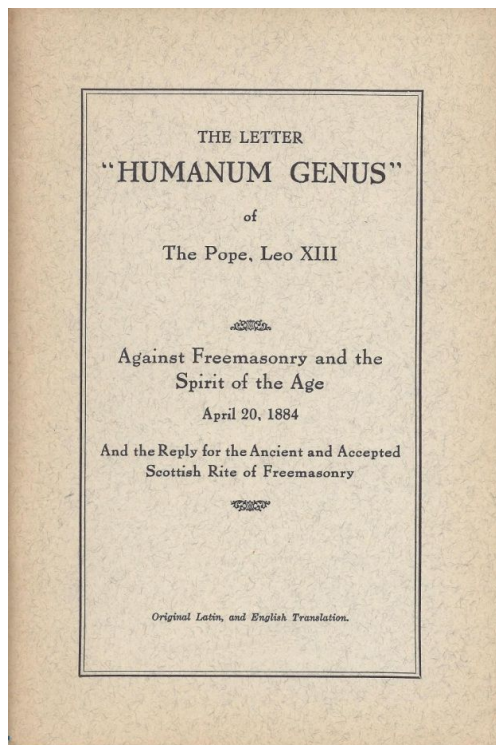

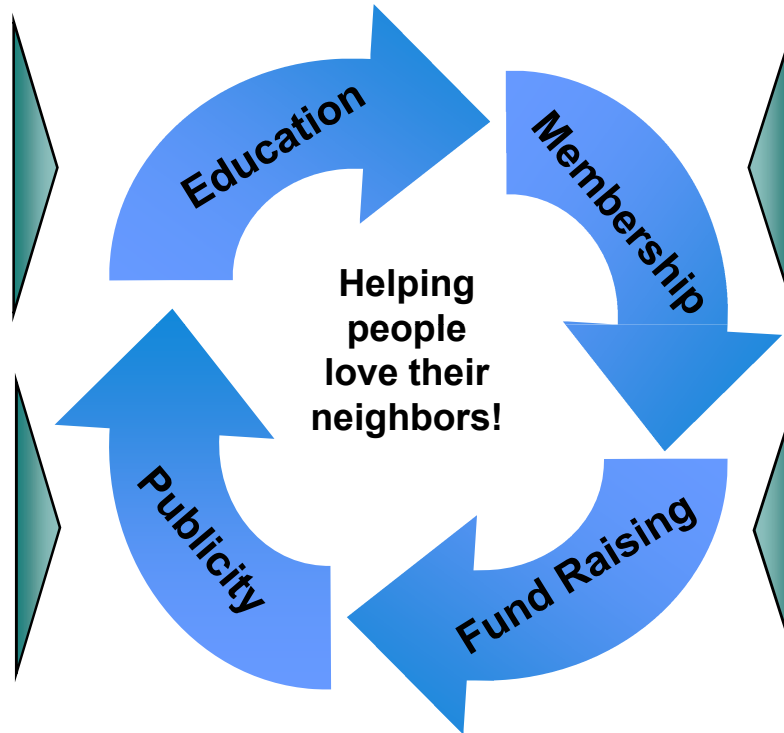

- + On the 70th anniversary of the atomic bombing of Japan, reach millions of people via *The Secret of Nagasaki and Atomic Bomb Secrets* documentaries via television and the internet.
- + Deepen knowledge of the Bible and Fatima solution with *Defeating the Brotherhood of Death* and the *Vigilant Christian* books.
- + Implement online programs that each year build upon the prior year to produce a world-class education resources to defeat organized evil.
- + Expose the root causes of poverty in a way that save souls and prevent a third world war.

2015 Teach Peace Programs	Success Metrics
1. <i>Atomic Bomb Secrets/ The Secret of Nagasaki</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sell the documentary. ▪ Generate at least \$100,000 in license and accompanying book revenue. ▪ Arrange U.S. home showings of the documentary via membership.
2. Solutions to the secret war against Christ and His people (e.g., <i>Defeating the Brotherhood of Death</i> book)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Sell 1,000 books at \$20 per book which includes a DVD.
3. <i>Vigilant Christian</i> book series	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Promote the Secret of Nagasaki and other Vigilant Christian education via radio, churches, the internet, and phone outreach. ▪ Improve the Vigilant Christian education website and videos. ▪ Generate at least \$35,000 in book revenue (e.g., this equates to about 2,000 books). Individual book pricing is VC I - \$15, VC II - \$20, VC III - \$20, VC IV – \$15 and VC V - \$15 or the series for \$65.

Volunteer Time = \$1,785,720

We need to generate income in 2015 to enable full time volunteers to continue as paid staff. We also need to fund expenses to translate and promote the documentary in Japan. A third funding need is for programs to raise awareness of our educational materials.

2014 Successes

2014 Teach Peace Programs	Success Metrics
<p>1. <i>The Secret of Nagasaki</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Four Teach Peace Foundation trips to Japan accomplished multiple good outcomes. ▪ First showing of the documentary was in Nagasaki on March 22, 2014. Feedback resulted in our improving the documentary with additional video shot in Japan and Korea. ▪ Total online documentary views = 17,000. ▪ Over 1,000 <i>The Secret of Nagasaki</i> DVDs with a similar number of books (including the <i>Atomic Bomb Secrets</i> book). This was less than our plan which was a result of two factors. The first and primary reason is progress in Japan did not drive book sales. The second and lesser reason is David Dionisi spent part of 2014 volunteering to help with Ebola crisis in Liberia.
<p>2. <i>The Brotherhood of Death</i> and <i>Vigilant Christian</i> book series</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ The book was completed in 2014 along with the <i>Atomic Bomb Secrets</i> book. ▪ Improved the Vigilant Christian education website. ▪ Plan was to generate \$35,000 in book revenue and actual was \$11,000. The additional \$24,000 was dependent on the documentary reaching a larger audience.

<p>2. <i>Special Ambassadors (covers all Africa services)</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Cared for just over 75 disabled children. ▪ Delivered emergency aid every month in Liberia, Africa. ▪ Helped disabled children attend school by supporting the Our Lady of Fatima Rehabilitation school. ▪ Supported the Liberian Glory business at the Our Lady of Fatima Rehabilitation Center.

<p>2. <i>Special Ambassadors</i></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Cared for 72 disabled children . ▪ A total of 12 emergency aid deliveries to the Our Lady of Fatima Rehabilitation Center. ▪ Funded 70 children to attend school. ▪ Managed the Model Village center to teach agriculture and livestock skills. ▪ Created a the new Special Ambassadors website.

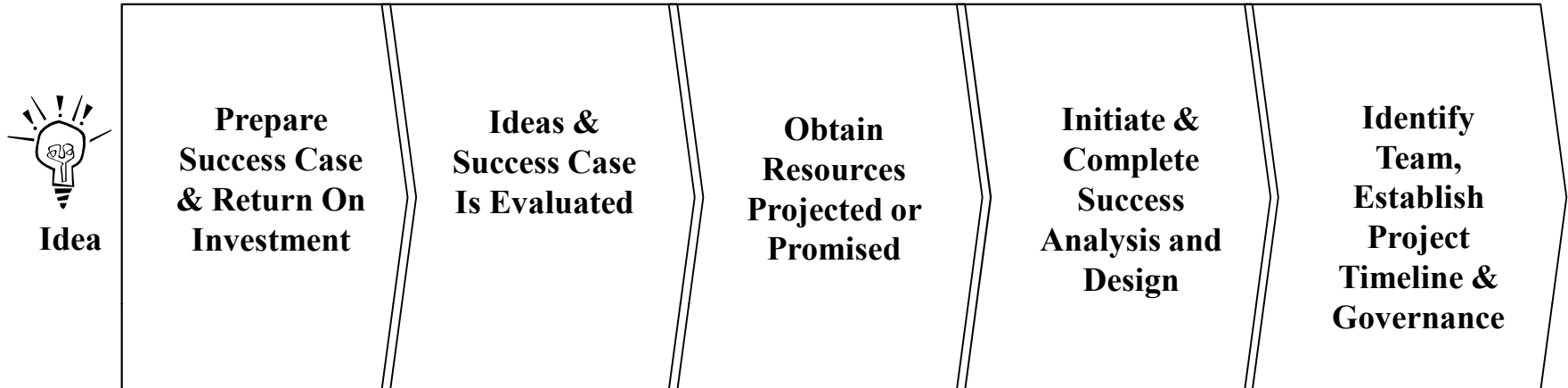
